These hotel price predictions for 150 key cities around the world range from steep rises to sharp falls, reflecting the wide variety of local market conditions that travel buyers face when budgeting and managing their accommodation programs.

Traveler security remains a priority for buyers, and this raises demand pressure in cities where options are limited to a selection of security-compliant properties. Other cities are seeing oversupply pushing prices down. Also note that these forecasts are in local currencies, so in destinations where inflation rates are volatile, the picture may look significantly different to those buying in foreign currencies.
